TNCBA Membership is \$25 each year. Membership runs from Jan. 1st - Dec. 31st. Tournament entry fees are \$20 per angler for each event. The classic is a non-entry fee event.	All competing teams must be registered by 7:00pm on the Thursday prior to the tournament. Anglers can register at the monthly meeting or via the registration link on the website. A 24-Hour Off-Limits will be enforced for each event except for the out-of-town event on Guntersville.	Payouts are in the form of gift cards and prizes. The focus of the TNCBA is a fellowship that is Christ centered and aimed at giving back to others. The majority of our entry fees goes to local charities each year. Gift cards are awarded to 1st - 5th and for Big Bass of the tournament.	Honor starts mean that anglers may launch from any ramp of their choosing on tournament waters and make their way to their starting spot prior to the designated start time. Anglers may only go directly to their starting spot and may not use that time to graph/locate fish. At the designated time, anglers may make their first cast. It is responsibility of the anglers to be at the weigh-in site, by water or trailer, by the designated check-in time. Failure to be at the weigh-in site by the check-in time will result in a penalty.	Anglers will be awarded (3) AOY drops over the course of the (11) tournament season. (Includes the Classic) Effectively, an anglers 8 best tournaments will be counted towards their AOY standings. This classic can be dropped. Teams will be awarded (2) TOY drops over the course of the (10) tournament season. (Does Not Include the Classic) The classic is an individual weight tournament and does not award points for team weight. Effectively, a teams 8 best tournaments will count towards their TOY standings.	Bonus points are awarded for the following: Attending Meetings, Big Bass, Spot > 3lbs., Smallmouth > 4lbs., Largemouth > 5lbs., and this year we will also be including three bonus point tournaments to our schedule. Bonus points cannot be dropped and are applied to the AOY total. (*Bonus points do NOT apply to the TOY standings.	Anglers must fish 6 tournaments in order to qualify for the TNCBA Classic.
