TNCBA Membership is \$25 each year. Membership runs from Jan. 1st - Dec. 31st. Tournament entry fees are \$20 per angler for each event. The classic is a non-entry fee event.	All competing teams must be registered by 7:00pm on the Thursday prior to the tournament. Anglers can register at the monthly meeting or via the registration link on the website. A 24-Hour Off-Limits will be enforced for each event.	Payouts are in the form of gift cards and prizes. The focus of the TNOSA is a fellowship that is Christ centered and aimed at giving back to others. The majority of our entry fees goes to local charaties each year. Gift cards are awarded to 1st - 5th and for Big Bass of the tournament.	Honor starts mean that anglers may launch from any ramp of their choosing on tournament waters and make their way to their starting spot prior to the designated start time. Anglers may only go directly to their starting spot and may not use that time to graph/locate fish. At the designated time, anglers may make their first cast. It is responsibility of the anglers to be at the weigh-in site, by water, by the designated check-in time. Failure to be at the weigh-in site by the check-in time will result in a pound penalty for each minute late up to ten minutes.	TNCBA Youth Series Teams will be awarded (2) drops over the course of the 7 tournament regular season. Effectively, each teams best five tournaments will count towards the TOY standings. A Team of the Year will be crowned following the final regular season event on Douglas Lake, November 23rd. The TNCBA Youth Series Classic will not count towards the Team of the Year standings.	One expectation of each team is that they complete a fishing report after each event. A goal of the TNCBA Youth Series to help anglers grow in understanding seasonal patterns and techniques. Following each event anglers will be sent a link to a Google Form with questions about their day on the water. The goal is to gather general information, not detailed specifics or waypoints. The anglers will be expected to complete the fishing report within 48 hours of the completion of an event.	The Top 5 Youth Series Teams will qualify for the TNCBA Youth Series Classic
